## Cardigan Sweater FOR THE MAKE-ALONG DOLL

Fits the 16" Make-Along doll and other similarly sized cloth dolls.

Knitting needles: size 2 US (2.75mm) 16" circular

or straight needles and DPNs

Yarn weight/size: fingering sock weight - 20g or

90 yards (80 meters)

4 x 1/4" buttons

Gauge: 32 sts x 34 rows = 4" stockinette stitch

**Abbreviations** 

K = knit

P = purl

Sts = stitch(es)

K2tog = knit next 2 stitches together

YO = yarn over

kfb = knit into front and back of same stitch

SM = slip marker, PM = place marker, RM = remove marker

This cardigan is knitted top down and reduces seaming. If you can knit in the round, you can do sleeves like that and there is no seaming, if not you have just 2 seams up under arms of sleeves. The cardigan has a garter stitch placket.

On increase rows, kfb on the stitch in front of and after the marker. You will increase 8 sts on each increase row.

Cast on 40 sts

Row 1-5: Knit 5 rows of K2, P2 rib

Row 6: K3, P5, PM, P6, PM, P12, PM, P6, PM, P5, K3

Row 7: K7, kfb, SM, kfb, K4, kfb, SM, kfb, K10, kfb, SM, kfb, K4, kfb, SM, kfb, K7 (48 sts)

Row 8: K3, P42, K3

Row 9: K8, kfb, SM, kfb, K6, kfb, SM, kfb, K12, kfb, SM, kfb, K6, kfb, SM, kfb, K8 (56 sts)

Row 10: K3, P50, K3

Row 11: K9, kfb, SM, kfb, K8, kfb, SM, kfb, K14, kfb, SM, kfb, K8, kfb, SM, kfb, K9 (64 sts)

Row 12: K2 tog, YO, K1, P58, K3 - first buttonhole

Row 13: K10, kfb, SM, kfb, K10, kfb, SM, kfb, K16, kfb, SM, kfb, K10, kfb, SM, kfb, K10 (72 sts)

Row 14: K3, P66, K3

Row 15: K11, kfb, SM, kfb, K12, kfb, SM, kfb, K18, kfb, SM, kfb, K12, kfb, SM, kfb, K11 (80 sts)

Row 16: K3, P74, K3

Row 17: K12, kfb, SM, kfb, K14, kfb, SM, kfb, K20, kfb, SM, kfb, K14, kfb, SM, kfb, K12 (88 sts)

Row 18: K3, P82, K3



Row 19: K13, kfb, SM, kfb, K16, kfb, SM, kfb, K22, kfb, SM, kfb, K16, kfb, SM, kfb, K13 (96 sts)

Row 20: K3, P90, K3

Row 21: K14, kfb, SM, kfb, K18, kfb, SM, kfb, K24, kfb, SM, kfb, K18, kfb, SM, kfb, K14 (104 sts)

Row 22: K2tog, YO, K1, P98, K3 - second buttonhole

Row 23: K15, kfb, SM, kfb, K20, kfb, SM, kfb, K26, kfb, SM, kfb, K20, kfb, SM, kfb, K15 (112 sts)

Row 24: K3, P106, K3

## Separating sleeves

Row 25: K17, move next 22 sts onto waste yarn, K34, move next 22 sts onto waste yarn, K17 (68 sts)

Row 26: K3, P14, CO 2 sts at underarm, P34, CO 2 sts at underarm, P14, K3 (72 sts)

Row 27: K

Row 28: K3, P66, K3

Row 29: K

Row 30: K3, P66, K3

Row 31: K

Row 32: K2tog, YO, K1, P66, K3 - third buttonhole

Row 33: K

Row 34: K3, P66, K3

Row 35: K

Row 36: K3, P66, K3

Row 37: K

Row 38: K3, P66, K3

Row 39: K

Row 40: K3, P66, K3

Row 41: K

Row 42: K2tog, YO, K1, P66, K3 - fourth buttonhole

Row 43: K

Row 44-48: K2, P2 rib for 5 rows

Bind off in rib

Sleeve - Knit in the round

Place 22 sts onto 3 needles

Pick up 2 sts from underarms and K22 (24 sts)

Continue in the round and knit for 24 rows

K2, P2 rib for 5 rows, Bind off in rib

Sleeve - Knit flat and seam up

Place 22 sts onto needle

Pick up 2 sts from underarms and K22 (24 sts)

Continue in stockinette stitch for a total of 24 rows

K2, P2 rib for 5 rows, Bind off in rib

Cut yarn, leaving 12" tail and use this yarn to seam up sleeve to underarm.

Block sweater and sew on four ¼" buttons to line up with button holes.
